The Ullman Center is both a Classroom Building and Vocational Education facility. The classroom portion consists of a Lecture Hall, Classrooms for Art, Agriculture, and Civil Technologies, and Offices for the Instructors. This portion is separated from the Vocational Education Unit by a level change of twelve (12) feet. The Vo-Tech portion includes a Large Shop Area, Smaller Work Areas, a Classroom, and Storage Rooms.

The major challenges overcome by the design were sound isolation between the various spaces while providing an elegant looking building on campus to house the Vo-Tech facilities.
