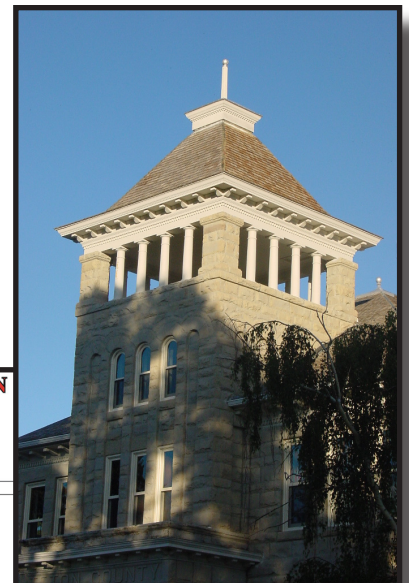

The work at Teton County Courthouse required our design team to analyze the space needs of all county services, determine whether they were or were not wheelchair accessible, and evaluate the life expectancy of each structure.

Our master plan resulted in an addition and remodeling to the courthouse that consolidated most of the county services into one facility eliminating the need for several rented offices around town. This addition will also replace the 1890's jail and consolidate law enforcement with the rest of the county services in the courthouse.
